### **SCAM and PHISHING ALERT**

To avoid scams, you should be cautious of unsolicited communications, especially those requesting personal information or urgent payments. Verify the identity of anyone claiming to be from a legitimate organization and never send money or sensitive information to unknown individuals or through unconventional methods like gift cards, wire transfers, or cryptocurrency.

- Don't answer calls from unknown numbers, and be wary of emails, texts, or social media messages from unfamiliar sources.
- Don't be pressured to act quickly: Scammers often create a sense of urgency to prevent you from thinking critically.
- Don't share sensitive information: Never give out personal information like social security numbers, bank details, or credit card numbers over the phone, email, or online unless you initiated the contact.
- Verify before you act: If someone claims to be from a legitimate organization, verify their identity by contacting the organization directly using a trusted phone number or website.


